## Lists of songs for KET Sets 1-5 and general objectives for each

You will find a listing of all of the songs in KET Sets 1-5. Next to each song title is a list of the general objective of the song. Each song can have several different objectives that you can emphasize, however, we have given the main one in this listing. To summarize briefly, this is the basic goal of each set:

KET Set 1 – The most basic set which emphasizes simple vocabulary and imitation of words and phrases.

KET Set 2 – Also teaches vocabulary, but at a higher level than KET Set 1. Emphasizes understanding questions, sequencing tasks, and multiple syllable imitation.

KET Set 3 – Emphasizes articulation from vowels to specific consonants. Also has motor imitation tasks.

KET Set 4 – A set that is entirely in Spanish with emphasis of imitation to direction following.

KET Set 5 – Emphasizes animal sounds, names, and actions.

### KET SET 1 (504)

This set includes the two CDs *Imitation Station* and *Vocalocomotion*, with 30 songs and raps that focus on developing imitation and interaction in children at the beginning stages of communication. The vocabulary is simple and repetitive and gives verbal practice of sounds, words, and simple phrases. Adults and children take verbal turns as they sing these songs.

13. Bye, Bye – Two-word phrases/common objects

1. Booga Choo Choo – Two-syllable combinations

3. The new BMW- B, M, W in syllables
4. Tongue Tip Time – T, D, N in syllables

### **KET SET 2 (504)**

This set includes the two CDs, *Conversation Station* and *Rocking & Talking*, with 24 songs that focus on a variety of tasks from simple consonant-vowel and single word practices to more complex exercises such as understanding and answering questions, making comments, recognizing environmental sounds, and sequencing steps to daily routines. These two CDs are the most diverse of the Kids' Express Train CDs and feature well known rock and roll tunes that have been re-written for young children.

### **KET SET 3 (505)**

This set includes the two CDs, *Drills On Wheels 1* and *Drills On Wheels 2*, and are packed with specific speech sound articulation drill. This upbeat and catchy collection of simple songs and raps is excellent for any child who would benefit from practice on the following sounds: vowels, h, m, t, d, n, k, f, s, sh, ch, and j. It also includes 2 songs featuring gross motor imitation using scarves.

### KET SET 4 (507)

This set includes the two CDs, *Digo y canto 1* and *Digo y canto 2*, and includes 29 Spanish songs that enhance the speech and language development of children learning Spanish. The songs focus on a variety of speech and language tasks from simple imitation of sounds, words, and phrases to direction-following tasks. The vocabulary emphasizes common Spanish words for young children from toddlers to early elementary age.

#### Digo y canto 1 CD

1. La canción del mono (The Song of the Monkey) – Gross motor imitation and vowel imitation.
2. Bebo más (I Drink More) – Common vocabulary related to drinks.
3. Brinca (Jump) – Interaction with others, communicative intent, and eye contact.
4. Soplo burbujas (I Blow Bubbles) – Following simple directions with body parts and imitation of single words and phrases.
5. Perro, Perro, Perro (Dog, Dog, Dog) – Action words and the word, "dog," plus barking sound imitation.
6. La bomba (The Balloon) – Imitation of words beginning with "b" plus articles.
7. Mi cuerpo (My Body) – Body parts.
8. ¡Me gusta ! (I Like It!) – Common object names.
9. A – a Dilo conmigo (Ah – Ah Say It With Me) – 3-syllable words beginning with A.
10. ¿Quién? (Who?) – Words beginning with the hard "c" sound, actions, and understanding "Who" questions.
11. Mi Gato Gordo (My Fat Cat) – Words beginning with "g," action words, and descriptive words
12. Adiós (Bye Song) – 2-word phrases and common objects.
- 13-14 – Instrumentals of Mi cuerpo and Adiós for your own verses

#### Digo y canto 2 CD

1. Hola (Hi) – 2-word phrases and common objects.
2. Vocales (Vowels) – Vowel sounds
3. Dime B M D (Tell Me B M D) – Consonant+vowel imitation
4. Arriba y abajo (Up and Down) – Prepositions
5. Animales, ¿Dónde están? (Animals, Where are You?) - Animals
6. Toca (Touch) – Body parts
7. ¡Vámonos! (Let's Go) – Vehicles
8. Yo como (I Eat) – Foods

9. Sí sé (Yes, I know) – S words
10. Mi ropa (My Clothes) – Clothing

### **KET SET 5 (508)**

Our KET Set 5, *Animals Movin' and Groovin'*, contains 12 songs focusing on animals, the sounds they say, and the actions they do. Children are often fascinated with animals, so we wanted to feature some of our favorite animals in this collection of songs. The primary goals of this set include encouraging engagement with others through the use of music, improving the ability to take turns, increasing imitation of actions, and increasing learning of animal names and the sounds they make.

In addition to the 12 songs, KET Set 5 also includes a collection of 12 Animal Face Posters, and a CD-ROM including pictures of animals and scenes to enhance the songs in this set and a manual of activities.
